



New Club Requirements and Procedures

CURRENT:

1. Affiliated with NJ Youth Soccer, Two Teams, Two Fields, One License Referee per every three teams, two Officers

SUGGESTED ADDITIONS:

2. New Clubs which have fields or players within the same geographical location as an existing MNJYSA club
 - a. must have participated with a sanctioned New Jersey youth Soccer League for a minimum of (choose one)
 - i. one (1) season
 - ii. two (2) seasons
 - iii. three (3) seasons
 - iv. four (4) seasons
 - b. New clubs in this category agree that MNJYSA may contact any of its' current member clubs to determine if there are any negative concerns or potential impact on the existing MNJYSA member club by allowing the new club to join MNJYSA.
3. New Clubs which are currently participating in any youth soccer League within the state of New Jersey agree that MNJYSA may check with any and all other Youth Soccer Leagues to determine the club is in Good Standing
 - a. Should the other Soccer League not respond to request for status the club will be considered as if it is in fact in Good Standing with that League
4. The Deadline for new club applications will be changed from June 1 to July 15 for Fall Seasons, and from December 1 to January 1 for Spring Seasons
5. No poll votes for conditional acceptance or adding to Flight Placement process will be allowed
6. New Clubs may only be approved by the Executive Board (at regular or special meeting) after completion of the above investigation.
